SUBJECT: **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14
TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING ON B954 MUIRHEAD - ALYTH -
GLENISLA ROAD AT NETHER SCITHIE, KILRY**

In order to carry out verge maintenance works a temporary Order will be promoted coming into effect from 12 November 2018 and continuing for a period of 2 weeks.

The Order will prohibit the driving of vehicular traffic on B954 Muirhead - Alyth - Glenisla Road from its junction with B951 Kirriemuir - Glenisla Road southwards to its junction with the access to Nether Scithie, a distance of 400 metres or thereby.

The Order will be effective between 8.00am and 4.00pm daily but the road will be open for vehicular traffic overnight. Access for pedestrians and emergency vehicles and vehicular access to affected properties will be maintained at all times.

The alternative route for vehicular traffic is via B951 Kirriemuir - Glenisla Road / Lintrathen - Prosen Bridge Road / Blackhill - Lintrathen Road. The reverse route applies.
